## A BLESSING TO THE WORLD

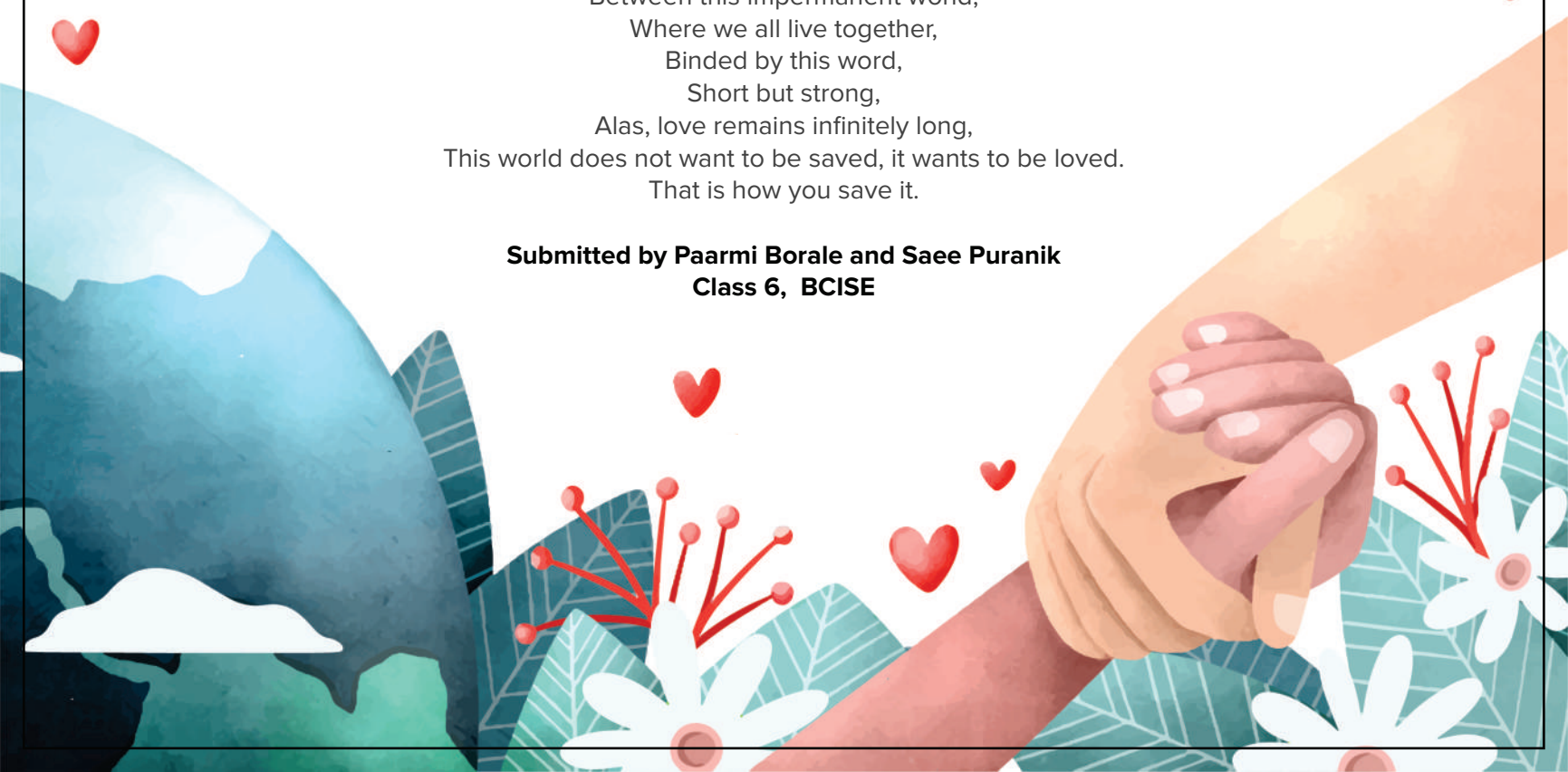
A light called love shining so bright,

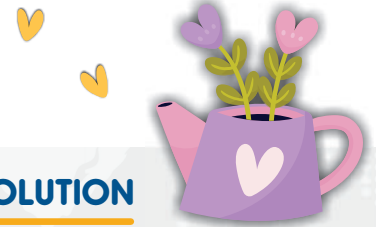
## SELFLESS LOVE

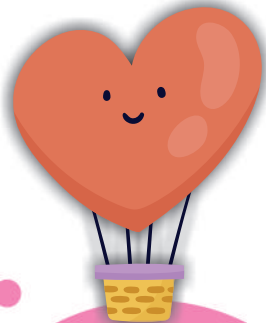


## CURE FOR CRUELTY

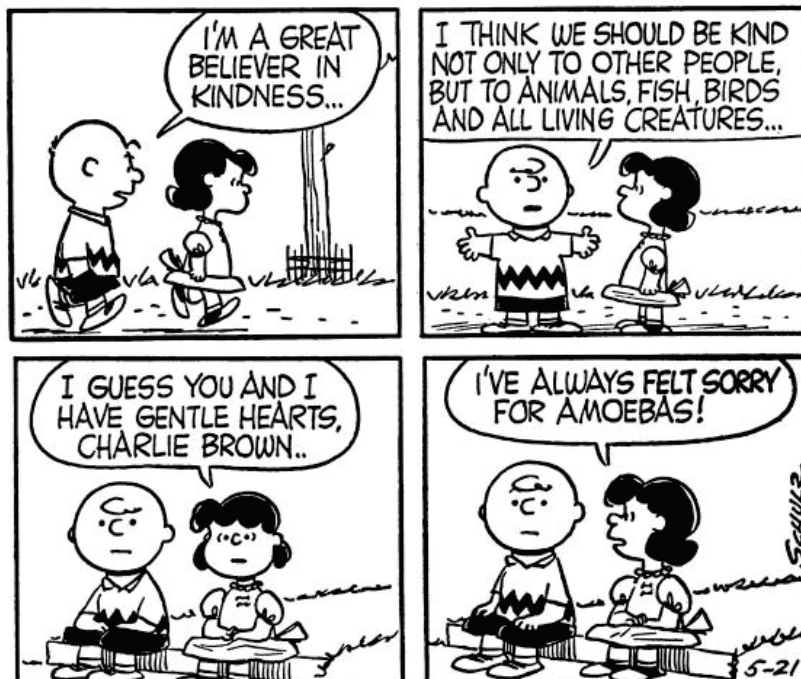
## A WORLD OF LOVE

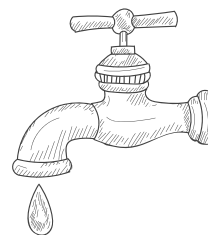
