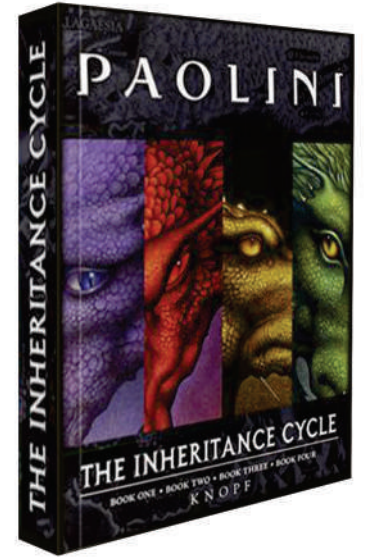

The first of four books in the "Inheritance Cycle," written by Christopher Paolini as a 15-year-old, was titled Eragon, the first in the four-book series. The self-published book took him two years to write and rewrite, and a third year to promote.



It seems as if there are a lot of loose ends at the end of the first book, but as the series goes on, each detail has a greater significance and it all comes together so beautifully. In the end, readers will find that even trivial details they may have overlooked are of extreme importance.

I found the series to be quite refreshing as a whole. Together, the writing style and the vast and detailed world of Alagaësia make the reader feel as if they are part of the universe. 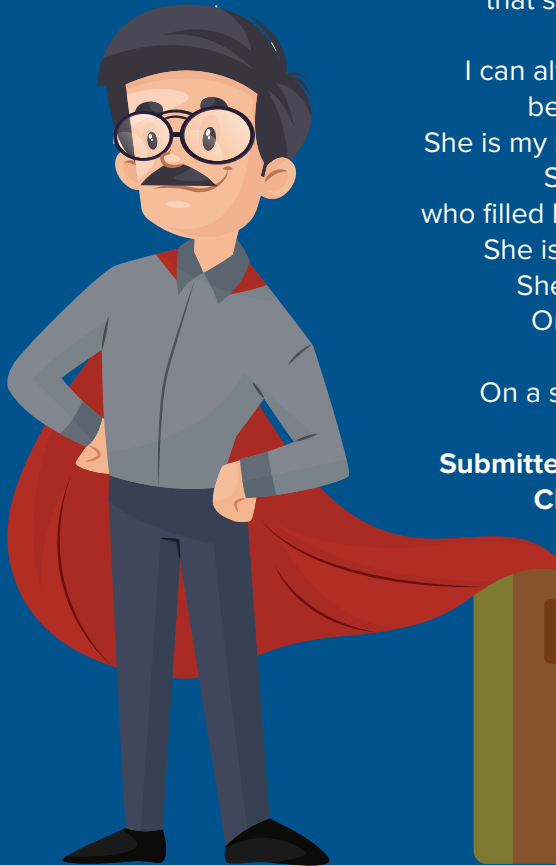

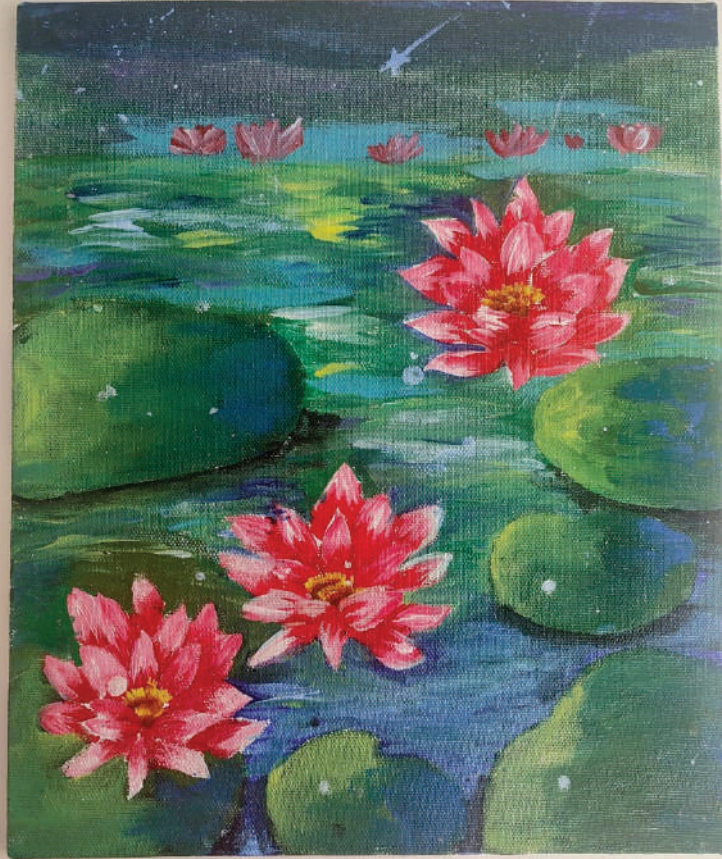
